On Friday morning before the March, we meet at 5:30 for breakfast in the hotel. Then we board the bus for a ride to the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception (largest Catholic Church in the western hemisphere). All are invited to 7:30 a.m. Mass in the upper level of the Basilica. When Mass is over, about 9:15 a.m., meet the group outside on the front steps. The bus will take us to the heart of the city, where we can tour the monuments or the Smithsonian museums. We will gather near the Washington Monument for the Rally at **noon**, right across from the White House and hear fantastic speakers! The March begins about 1:30 p.m. We walk along Constitution Avenue to the Capitol Building and the Supreme Court. Truly an awesome, overwhelming experience!

After the March, we will meet at a specific time & location and get on our bus and then go out to dinner. After dinner we will go back to the hotel & get a good night's sleep.

Our bus will leave on Saturday 1/23/16 at 6:00 a.m. and we will arrive back in Lapeer at approximately 6:00 p.m.
